## How do I attend a program on Google Meet:

If you are on a computer, just click on the meeting link to join. If you are using a tablet or smartphone, you will need to download the Google Meet App. You will need a google account to log into the app. From your email, click on the meeting link. To mute yourself — tap on the picture, then tap on the microphone, to leave the meeting tap on the picture — tap on the telephone handset.
