At-Home COVID-19 Test Kits

WCDPL is distributing free, at-home COVID-19 test kits. Kits are in short supply.

If you need proof of the results of this test (work, travel, etc.) **do not open the test kit until instructed to by the online proctor.** For that type of documentation, you will need to download the Navica app on a device with a camera. You will be required to use the camera throughout the test. The instructor needs to see you open the test in front of them for it to be valid.

Expiration Dates

Although originally marked for expiry in September of 2021, kits now have a longer expiry date. We have links on our website detailing both new expiration dates and additional expiry information.

If an eMed telehealth proctor advises someone that their test is expired, but the test has not reached the extended date identified in the link on our website, you should ask to speak to an eMed supervisor. However, if you are attempting to use a test that has reached the extended expiration date, then the eMed telehealth proctor will be unable to proceed with administration of the test.

Please understand that these test kits will expire, so the longer you have them without using them, the more chance you have of them reaching their expiration date.
