Technology questions? *The Connectivity Champions* can assist you with all of your needs, at no cost to all Ohioans.

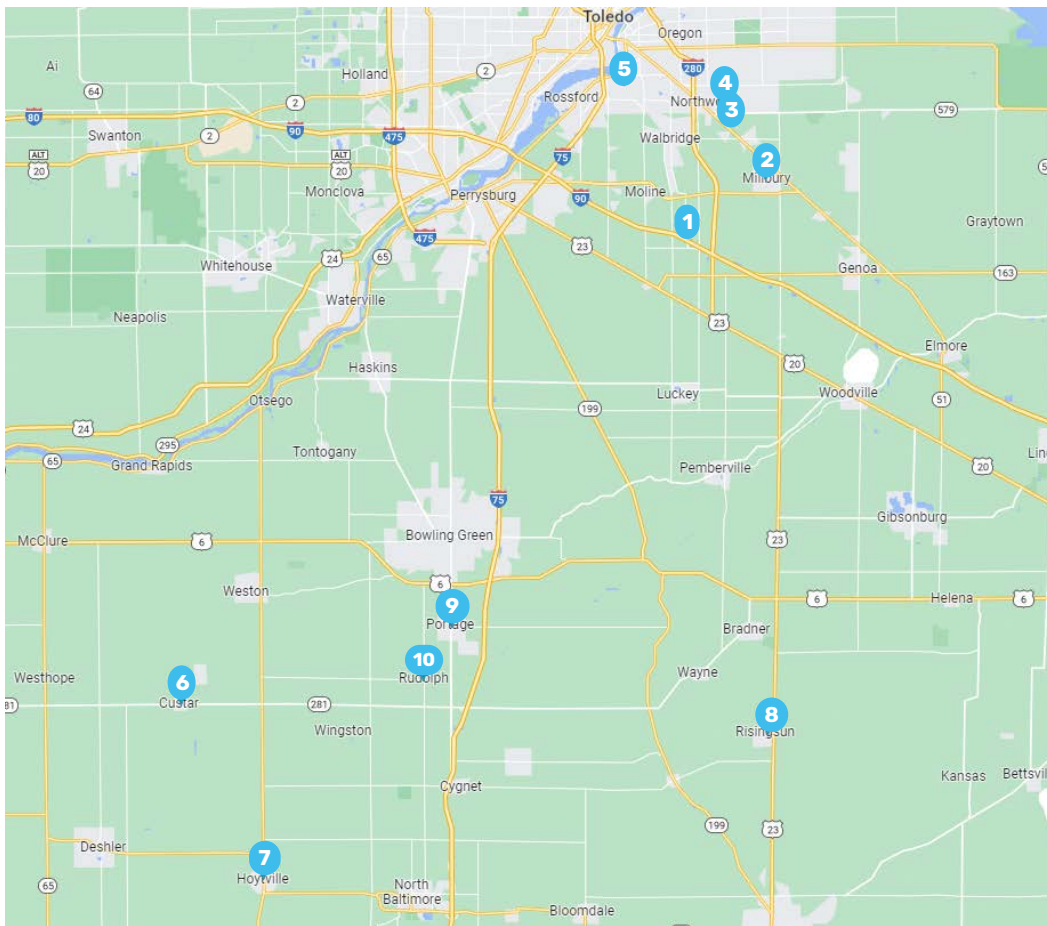


WCDPL's Outreach Department takes library services on the road!

What is the Bookmobile? The WCDPL Bookmobile is a full-service mobile library. The Bookmobile is open to all ages and carries a variety of materials. Receive a free library card; pick up take-home activities and coloring supplies; borrow books, audiobooks, movies, and CDs; grab a free magazine; request reference assistance; place holds; renew materials; register to vote; and more!
